Examples:	What does this mean? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have 20 employees and 1 establishment you could ask us to contribute a maximum of £1200 towards your training. • If you have 20 employees and between 2-4 establishments you could ask us to contribute up to a maximum of £840 per establishment (£1200 - 30% = £840) • If you have 40 employees and between 2 - 4 establishments you could ask us to contribute up to a maximum of £980 per establishment (£1400 - 30 % = £980) • If you have 100+ employees and over 5 establishments you could be asking us to contribute up to a maximum of £ 720 per establishment. (£1800 - 60% = £720)
